This scam consists of the DTS user receiving an email asking them to "log Into DTS at the following link: *www.defensetravel. osd.com* to sign their authorization immediately or their travel reservations are subject to cancellation." The website accepts the user's CAC pin log-in information which may ultimately comprise their digital certificates. Did You Know you may be eligible for the Active Duty Dental Program (ADDP) if they fall into one of the following categories: 1. On active duty for more than 30 days, 2. Designated in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) as an "Early Activator", 3. In Transition Assistance Management Program (TAMP) status following activation for a contingency operation for more than 30 days. Eligible service members who utilize the ADDP can receive civilian dental care with no out-of-pocket expenses for covered services. AF to implement force structure changes The Air Force released its plan Mar. 28 to implement force structure changes mandated by the Fiscal Year 2013 National Defense Authorization Act. "... The NDAA directs a reduction of 65 aircraft and approximately 1,400 military billets from the Air National Guard, 57 aircraft from the Air Force Reserve, and 122 aircraft and approximately 6,100 military billets from the active-duty Air Force."
