


Free Webinar: Establishing Positive Relationships Between Child Care Providers & Military Families

DTS Phishing Scam

There is a phishing scam directed at the users of the DTS System. It consists of the DTS user receiving an email asking them to log into DTS at the following link (www.defensetravel.osd.com) to sign their authorization immediately or their travel reservations are subject to cancellation. The recipient noted that the furnished link reflected a dot-com (.com) website address while the DTS website uses only a dot-mil (.mil) website address. The web-site accepts the user's CAC pin log-in information which may ultimately comprise their digital certificates.



If you receive any "DTS" email, use a link from your Bookmarks or manually enter the link into your browser to go to DTS. If you must use the link provided in the email, verify that it is a dot-mil (.mil) by RIGHT clicking on the link, select "Copy Link" from the pop-up menu, and then paste into your browser and verify the link is .mil.




