

## Basic Requirements for ANG Chaplaincy

1. Possess United States citizenship
2. Possess a baccalaureate degree with not less than 120 semester hours from a qualifying school
3. Possess a post-baccalaureate graduate degree with not less than 72 semester hours in the field of theology or related studies from a qualifying educational institution
4. Receive ecclesiastical endorsement for military chaplain ministry from a Department of Defense qualified Religious Organization
5. Interview with a senior chaplain representative of Air National Guard Chaplain Headquarters
6. Interview with the local Wing Chaplain
7. Meet Department of Defense and Air Force physical/medical standards and age requirements
  - Be within AF height and weight standards
  - Meet qualifying standards for a Commissioning physical
    - Be Age 42 or younger at commissioning (waiver is possible to Age 46)
8. Pass a Background Security Investigation and Financial Check
