Air Force officials will perform a major upgrade to the Military Personnel Data System, or MilPDS, March 2013. The Air Force Personnel Operations Agency here will upgrade and transfer MilPDS to the Defense Information Systems Agency Defense Enterprise Computing Center. The project is expected to take 23 days. During the upgrade, MilPDS will not be available.
